1. General

1.1. Organizer

- 1.1.1. The 2nd FAI World Intermediate Aerobatic Championship 2019 (WIAC) will take place under the auspices of the Czech National Aeroclub.
- 1.1.2. The operational Organizer is Aeroclub Břeclav, Airfield Břeclav, Czech Republic.

1.2. Place and Date

- 1.2.1. The event will take place at Břeclav Airfield (LKBA), located about 85 km North of Vienna and 50 km South of Brno (the second largest city of the Czech Republic).
- 1.2.2. More info about airfield is available at www.wiac2019.cz.
- 1.2.3. The event will take place in the period: **July 5th to July 13th, 2019.**
- 1.2.4. Official training days will begin on **July 2nd** and will end on **July 5th, 2019.**
- 1.2.5. Opening briefing will be on **July 5th, 2019 approximately at 20.00LT.**

1.3. Training Flights

- 1.3.1. Official training flights at LKBA airfield will be possible from July 2nd till July 5th, 2019. The competition box will be marked during official training days.
- 1.3.2. Earlier training flights are possible with previous agreement of the Organizer. In case of need, please contact the Organizer at e-mail: info@wiac2019.cz or via the contact information in part 10 of this document.
- 1.3.3. Training at other airfields in LKBA vicinity is possible with previous agreement of the Organizer. In case of need, please contact the Organizer at e-mail: info@wiac2019.cz or the other contact information in part 10 of this document.
- 1.3.4. Booking of slots for official training days will be available at the official contest website www.wiac2019.cz (in June).

1.4. Schedule

- 1.4.1. Official working hours of the Contest Office and the Organizer will be from 08.00LT to half an hour after the landing of the last competitor or 20.00LT whatever comes later.
- 1.4.2. These hours are valid for any official inquiries or information or deposit of claims/protest concerning the contest during the contest's period.
- 1.4.3. All times are stated in local time (LT=UTC+2 hrs).
- 1.4.4. The Schedule may be changed due to technical and organizational reasons as well as the weather conditions.

2. Regulations

2.1. Rules

2.1.1. The WIAC2019 will be conducted according to the following rules:

- FAI Sporting Code – General Section,
- FAI Sporting Code – Section 6 Part 1,
- Flight Rules published by the Civil Aviation Authorities of the Czech Republic,
- Local Regulations.

3. Participation, Competitors and Aircrafts

3.1. Participants

- 3.1.1. All FAI member NACs may be represented at the WIAC2019 by the team and/or an individual competitors/observer.
- 3.1.2. Entries will be accepted from National Aero Clubs only (according to FAI Sporting Code, Section 6 Part 1).
- 3.1.3. Other non-NAC entries will be accepted according to FAI Sporting Code, Section 6 Part 1.
- 3.1.4. Each competitor should be a holder of:
 - a valid Pilot License with an aerobatic extension according to competitor's national legislation,
 - a valid FAI Sporting License,
 - a valid Medical certificate.

3.2. Aircraft

- 3.2.1. All participating aircraft must satisfy the performance criteria essential for competition flights in the intermediate aerobatic category.
- 3.2.2. For all competing aircraft a valid Certificate of Airworthiness of the related country must be presented.
- 3.2.3. For all competing aircraft using the airspace of the Czech Republic, liability insurance must be concluded with respect to damage caused by operation of that aircraft to third parties covering a minimum amount in SDR (Special Drawing Rights) or in equivalent value of any other freely convertible currencies, for the aircraft with MTOW as mentioned below:
 - MTOW up to 1000 kg 1.500.000 SDR (approx. 1.800.000 EUR)
 - MTOW above 1000 kg to 2700 kg 3.000.000 SDR (approx. 3.600.000 EUR)
- 3.2.4. Each competing aircraft must be insured against 3rd Party Public Liability, according to EU Regulation (EC) No. 785/2004, claims with a minimum amount as mentioned above according to MTOW. Aircraft arriving to the Czech Republic must be able to present their insurance policy with a copy in English, certified by the Insurance Company.
- 3.2.5. All competing aircrafts must be equipped with VHF radio channel separation of 8,33 kHz according to Implementing Regulation (IR) 1079/2012 of European Commission valid from January 1st, 2018.
- 3.2.6. Hangar space for competing aircraft will be available free of charge for the period of the Championship.
- 3.2.7. In case of insufficient hangar capacity, priority will be determined by the Organizer. In case of doubt, the order of received Entry Fee payment dates will be taken in account.

4. Team Composition

4.1. Competitors

4.1.1. As specified in para 3.1. of this Bulletin.

4.2. Other Team Members

4.2.1. Each team may include the team members according to FAI Sporting Code, Section 6 Part 1.

4.3. Observers

4.3.1. Other persons (i.e. team member's relatives) will be accepted as observers of National Team. No Entry Fee for observers will be collected, but expenses with stay at the airfield, meals, accommodation and attendance at Opening and Closing ceremonies or other events of championship official program needs to be covered individually. This option will be available at info center during championship.

5. Entries and Registration

5.1. Deadline for the Entries

5.1.1. The Official Entry Forms as well as the Entry Fees must be provided to the Organizer not later than **May 17th, 2019**.

5.1.2. If payment is made later or at the contest site, an additional **EUR 200** will be charged.

5.1.3. Any participant wishing to query the arrival and clearance of their fees should contact the Organizer using e-mail info@wiac2019.cz or the other contact information in part 10 of this document.

5.1.4. Entry Fee must be paid in full amount and bank fees must be charged to sender's account.

5.2. Registration

5.2.1. Registration can be made using following communication channels:

- Ordinary mail - send your applications to AEROCLUB OF CZECH REPUBLIC at the address specified in part 10.1.
- Electronically using email – use email address info@wiac2019.cz in which case registrations should be considered as valid after confirmation from the Organizer.
- Electronically using the webform at website www.wiac2019.cz. In this case confirmation letter form NAC needs to be uploaded. More details available at contest website.

5.2.2. **Registration is valid and complete by submitting the Official Entry Forms** or online registration form with NAC confirmation by mail, e-mail or online **AND by accepted payment** at the bank account specified in part 10.1.

5.3. Free Known sequence submission

5.3.1. The Free Known sequence of each competitor should be submitted not later than two days before the opening briefing.

5.3.2. **Deadline for the Free Known submission is on July 2nd (TUE) at 23.59 LT.**

5.3.3. Competitors may submit their Free Known sequence to the e-mail address sequence@wiac2019.cz or info@wiac2019.cz. Every submission will be confirmed. **Sequence submissions are not valid without confirmation.**

5.3.4. Each competitor must submit a computer file of his Free Known sequence in only an acceptable format.

5.3.4.1. **PDF file** - the file must contain complete pages for forms "A", "B" and "C" as well as forms "L" and "R". The competitor is responsible that the software used has been updated to comply with the Aresti System (Condensed) and Section 6, Part 1 regulations as currently amended by CIVA.

5.3.4.2. **seq file** - The competitor is responsible that the software used has been updated to comply with the Aresti System (Condensed) and Section 6, Part 1 regulations as currently amended by CIVA.

5.3.4.3. **Visio file** - The competitor is responsible that the software used has been updated to comply with the Aresti System (Condensed) and Section 6, Part 1 regulations as currently amended by CIVA.

5.3.4.4. Every file (PDF/seq/visio) will contain following information (this is an example):

5.3.5. Hard copies alone or hand drawings will not be accepted.

6. Entry Fees

6.1. Entry Fees

6.1.1. Entry Fees are specified as follows:

- Competitor: **EUR 1900**
- Other team members and observers: **EUR 1600**

6.1.2. To pay the Entry Fee please use the bank details provided in the paragraph 11.1.1 .

6.1.3. The Entry Fee covers:

- Accommodation of the participant during the Championship
- 3 meals per day
- Official and social functions;
- Program arranged by the Organizer.
- The CIVA Sanction Fee, 160 EUR per pilot.

6.1.4. Single room will be charged by additional fee of **200 EUR**.

6.1.5. See para 5.1.2 for late payment fee.

6.2. Entry Fee Refund Policy

6.2.1. If a registered competitor or official should withdraw, his/her NAC may substitute another pilot or official with no financial penalty. If a participant wishes to cancel their entry, the NAC representative must contact the Organizer. The date of withdrawal will be noted by the Organizer and will set the proportion of the fee to be refunded by the Organizer.

6.2.2. Withdrawal before May 2nd, 2019 – 100% of the entry fee will be refunded.

6.2.3. Withdrawal after May 2nd and up to May 16th, 2019 – 50% of the fee will be refunded.

6.2.4. Withdrawal after May 17th, 2019 – no entry fee will be refunded (5 weeks in prior to the Organizer).

6.2.5. In the case of entry fee refunds the refunded amount will be reduced by any bank fees that apply on the Organizer side.

6.2.6. If a competitor is disqualified from the event according to FAI Sporting Code, Section 6 Part 1, no entry fee will be refunded.

7. Protests

7.1. Protest Fee

7.1.1. Protest must be submitted accompanied by the payment of 70 EUR.

8. Accommodation and catering

8.1. Accommodation

8.1.1. Accommodation for Competitors and other Team members will be covered by the Organizer from **July 5th** to **July 13th** (8 nights).

8.1.2. List of the hotels will be published on the contest website www.wiac2019.cz.

8.2. Catering

8.2.1. Three meals per day and refreshment for all participants will be arranged by the Organizer. Breakfast will be provided by hotel. Lunch and dinner will be provided at LKBA airfield.

8.2.2. Meals for Competitors and Team members will be provided from **July 5th** (dinner) to **July 12th** (dinner).

8.2.3. Meals and refreshment will be available during official training days in local airport restaurant.

9. Officials

9.1.1. No Entry Fee is required for CIVA appointed Officials.

9.1.2. Organizer covers accommodation and meals for following Officials:

- 3 members of International Jury.
- Chief Judge and 2 Assistants.
- 7 CIVA selected Judges.
- 7 CIVA selected Judge Assistants.

9.1.3. Accommodation for Officials will be covered by the Organizer from **July 5th** to **July 13th** (8 nights). Meals will be provided from **July 5th** (dinner) to **July 13th** (breakfast).

9.1.4. **Accommodation of all Officials will be in double rooms arranged by the Organizer.** The Organizer will try to fulfill any requests for specific accommodation needs, but **additional costs (i.e. single room) will not be covered.**

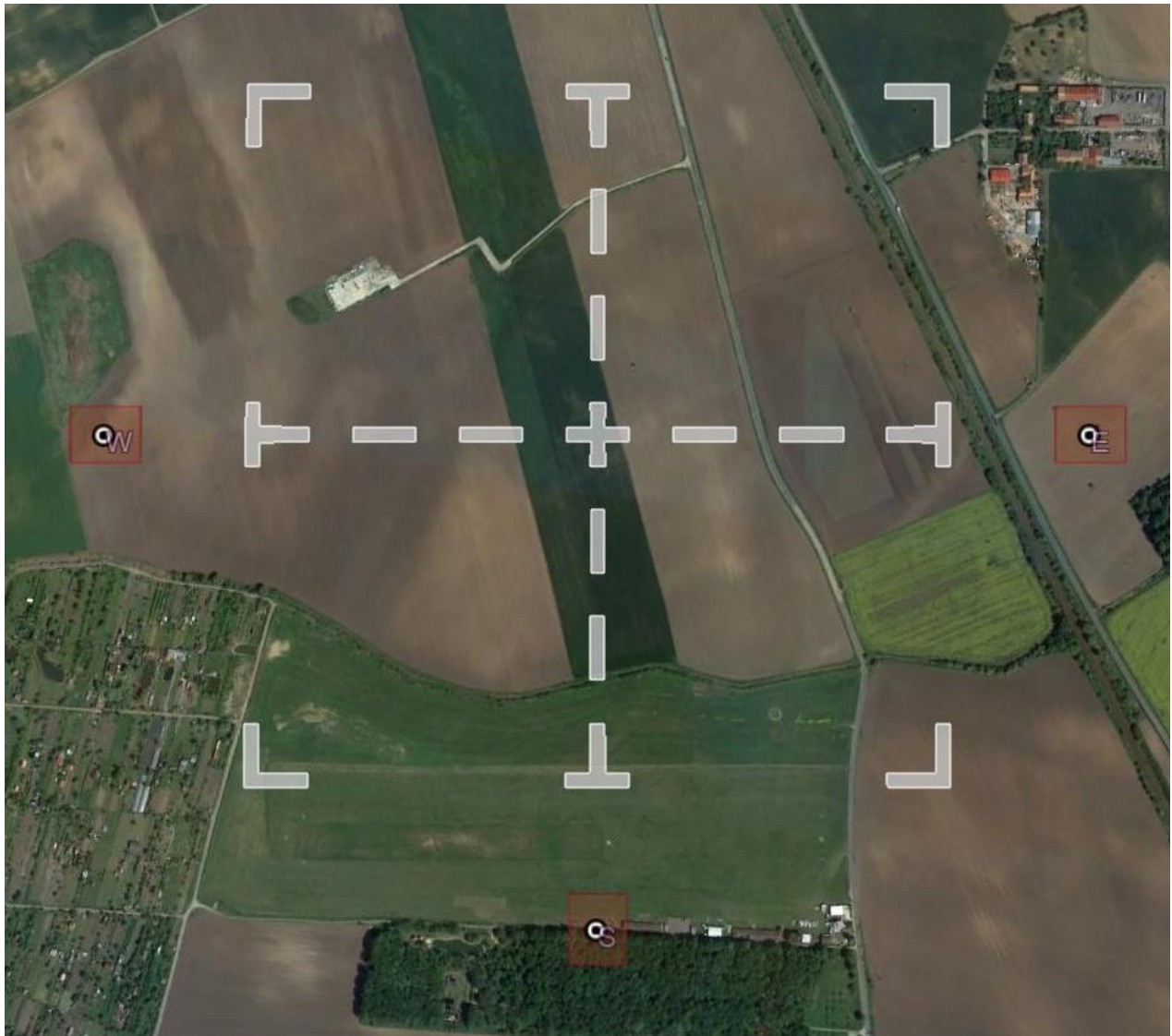
